Class Codes

Beginner: Little or no experience with fabric selection, rotary cutting equipment, and machine or hand piecing. Beginners should have basic working knowledge of their specific sewing machine for classes requiring a machine.

Intermediate: Previous class and individual experience with rotary cutting equipment and a variety of piecing or appliqué methods suggested. Should have a good understanding of basic quilt construction techniques.

Advanced: For those with substantial class and individual experience with quilt or clothing design and construction techniques.

Everyone must start somewhere, why not begin your quilting experience in Paradise! Twenty hours of teaching will give you a solid foundation of basic skills. Marcia will take you through the beginning steps of quilting: reading and understanding your pattern, accurate rotary cutting, precise piecing and assembling your blocks and borders. Tools of the trade and products you may not be familiar with will be introduced. This is an excellent class for beginners and anyone wanting to review basic quilting skills. Book: "All Things Quilting" by Alex Anderson is required. Pattern for Triple Rail will be provided in class.

** A RECIPE FOR YOU **

Dessert Delight - Serves 12

- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup pecans, chopped
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- 1 - 8oz package cream cheese (softened)
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2 cups whipping cream whited with a little sugar or 12 oz. carton of Cool Whip
- 1 small package instant chocolate pudding
- 1 small package instant vanilla pudding
- 2 cups cold milk



Mix together in a food processor flour, pecans and butter or margarine - the mixture should resemble crumbs. Pat into 9 x 13 inch baking dish and bake for 15 minutes at 350 degrees. Let it cool completely.

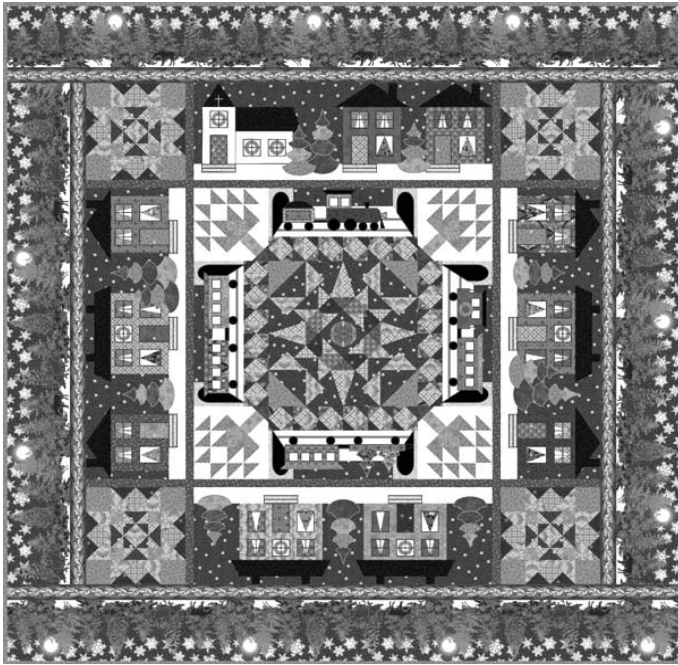
Cream together cream cheese and powdered sugar. Stir in one cup of whipped cream (or Cool Whip) and spread over cooled crust. Whip pudding mixes and milk together until thickened, and spread over cheese layer. Spread remaining whipped cream (or Cool Whip) on top.

Chill before serving.

This is a rich dessert that looks like you worked really hard to put it together. I usually top it with fresh raspberries or blueberries.

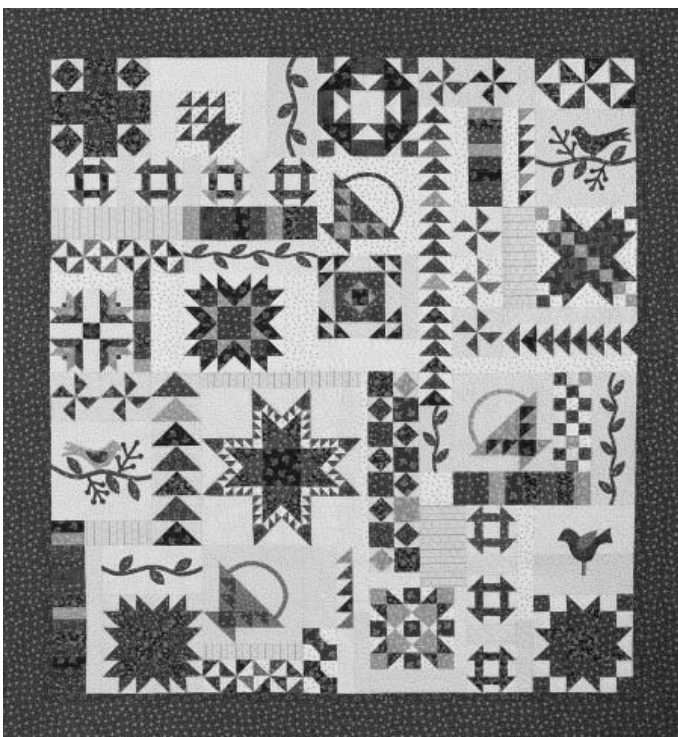


